Today, the Feast of Corpus Christi (the Body and Blood of Our Lord), is that personal invitation by Christ to each and every one of us. He shows us to our seat at that glorious banquet promised as our Eternal Reward in Heaven. The 'Bread of Angels' is our spiritual nourishment here on earth, food for the journey. This is the reason that the Eucharist remains the summit of our faith, and pinnacle of the Sacraments. Christ is OUR heavenly food. Today might therefore be seen as a mere glimmer of the endless joy that we will receive at the Heavenly Banquet.

The Sequence is an additional hymn of praise accompanying the Gospel within the Order of Mass, invites us into the richness of the faith with its mystical, poetic prose. The great theologian St Thomas Aquinas, undoubtedly one of the Church's finest teachers, presents us such rich imagery in his writing. Historically, Sequences have been included from the Fourth Century, and on four key Feasts (Easter Sunday, Pentecost, Corpus Christi, and Our Lady of Sorrows) we sing these to enhance and enrich our understanding in the life of faith and worship.

So... this is your invitation today. Christ already knows you replied 'yes' to His invitation by your attendance at Mass.

Come, behold the bread of angels! Come, to the Banquet of Heaven.



A loud shout raise to Jacob's God, rejoice in God our King; Sound timbrels, pluck the merry harp, And play the lyre and sing.


